

2011 JUSTIN LYNCH MEMORIAL **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

This scholarship has been established to honor the memory and accomplishments of Justin Michael Lynch of Mesquite, Texas. Justin graduated from Poteet High School in May of 2003 and began his studies at Eastfield Junior College, until entering Texas A&M University in the Fall of 2004. Growing up, Justin faced his own challenges with school but through perseverance and hard work he obtained his Bachelor's degree at Texas A&M University in December of 2007. He would have continued on to begin working towards his Master's degree in the Summer of 2009. As a math teacher and sponsor of different clubs at Agnew Middle School, Justin dedicated his life to education.

Eligibility:

At least one scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded, with the potential for multiple recipients, to a graduating Senior from Poteet High School in Mesquite, Texas. Each applicant must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or greater, on a 4.0 scale. The chosen applicant(s) must exhibit intelligence, hard work, and dedication to both their schooling and extracurricular activities. Finally, all applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 undergraduate hours).

Application must include:

1. COMPLETE application handwritten or typed (*Incomplete applications will not be considered*)
2. Copy of SAT &/or ACT results
3. Copy of *current* High School transcript (transcript does not have to be "official")
4. One reference from a teacher, counselor, or personal reference may be submitted (*optional*)

Applications must be turned in to the Poteet counseling office by April 15, 2011.

Distribution of Funds:

Scholarship recipients must provide proof of full-time enrollment before distribution of funds is made to the College/University Registrar. Upon receipt, every effort will be made such that funds are distributed no later than September 1, 2011.
